_____ANDY AZEVEDO PERPETUAL TROPHY

The Andy Azevedo Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to an outstanding 4-H or FFA member currently exhibiting at the Fair on the basis of community services, school involvement and sports (school-related or hobby: skiing etc.). Applicants must have completed the 8th grade as of June 18, 2016.

_____FLORENCE AND PATRICK DICKEY PERPETUAL TROPHY

Awarded to a 4-H Rabbit Exhibitor emphasizing accomplishment in his or her 4-H rabbit project as well as 4-H leadership, citizenship, and community service.

_____“PAPPY” NORTON PERPETUAL AWARD

Awarded to an outstanding FFA exhibitor based on project work, chapter involvement, leadership, citizenship and community service.

_____MILDRED PETERSEN PERPETUAL AWARD - \$50 CASH AWARD

The Sonoma-Marin Fair will recognize an outstanding 4-H exhibitor in the non-livestock department of the Fair. The non-livestock department includes the following sections: floriculture, foods, fine arts, ag mechanics, arts and crafts, photography, etc. Exhibitors who also show livestock (at this Fair) are **not** eligible to apply (Applicants will be notified of interview date, time, and location). **Candidates may bring three copies of a summary of achievements to the Sonoma-Marin Fair to the interview.**

_____CHARLES H. SOVEL PERPETUAL TROPHY

Awarded to a 4-H or FFA Poultry Exhibitor emphasizing accomplishment in his or her poultry project as well as leadership, citizenship, and community service.

_____JIM R. UNDERWOOD MEMORIAL AWARD - \$50 CASH AWARD

Awarded to an outstanding 4-H or FFA Breeding Swine Exhibitor at the Fair on the basis of project work, involvement and leadership within their project, community service, citizenship and sportsmanship.

_____SCOTTY MENDOZA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$300

Awarded to a resident of Marin or Sonoma Counties, having a 2.5 GPA or better and exhibiting in the still life department (non-livestock) at the current fair. The award will be based on community, school, and fair involvement. Applicant must be a graduated senior or older. Scholarship available upon proof of enrollment in a junior or four year college.
