

For the Safety and Enjoyment of all Fair Patrons

The following items are not allowed on the fairgrounds:

- Pets, with the exception of service dogs and registered contestants of the World's Ugliest Dog contest
- Glass or metal bottles, cans and containers
- Knives
- Guns, mace, clubs, or any item determined to be a weapon by Fair security
- Alcoholic beverages (may not be brought through the gate, but may be purchased on the grounds from Fair vendors)
- Drugs
- Bicycles, skateboards or scooters
- Ice chests

Smoking is not allowed, except in marked, designated smoking areas (County ordinances 5974 and 5953).

Guests may carry a plastic, reusable, water bottle.

Guest purses and bags will be searched by security.

Guests are expected to be courteous and respectful to fellow guests by not using profanity or engaging in unsafe, illegal, disruptive, disorderly, or offensive behavior.

Guests are required to wear shirts and shoes at all times.

Fairgrounds have many walking surfaces including grass, gravel, pavement, and dirt. **WATCH YOUR STEP.**

Sonoma-Marín Fair is not responsible for and assumes no liability arising from fire, theft, damage to or loss of vehicle, or any article left inside the vehicle, for persons parked at the Sonoma-Marín Fairgrounds. Please lock your car.

Distribution of items and solicitation are strictly forbidden except for entities scheduled and approved by the fair.

Guests entering the Sonoma-Marín Fair grant unrestricted rights and license to promoters, facility management and all other entities associated with the Sonoma-Marín Fair or their respective agents to use guests' likeness in any broadcast, telecast, photograph taken or other transmission or reproduction in connection with the event.
