****ATTENTION ALL LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS****

To exhibit in the Sonoma-Marín Fair youth livestock shows (excluding cavies and dogs), all exhibitors 9 years of age and older, are required to annually participate in a Quality Assurance and Ethics Awareness training. The Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) program has been approved to meet this requirement. Both online and in-person trainings will be available. Online training is \$12, and in-person training will cost \$3. Each exhibitor will receive a certificate and unique ID number upon completion of the program. This certification number must be submitted on your livestock entry form.
